## Ways To Give:

- Gifts in a will (bequests)
- IRA rollover/beneficiary designations (of all or part of a life insurance policy)
- Gifts from a donor advised fund
- Gifts of appreciated stock

### IRA Rollover

You may be looking for a way to make a big difference to help further our mission. If you are 70½ or older, an IRA charitable rollover is a way you can help continue our work and benefit this year.

#### Benefits of an IRA charitable rollover:

- Avoid taxes on transfers of up to \$100,000 from your IRA to our organization
- Satisfy your required minimum distribution (RMD) for the year
- Reduce your taxable income, even if you do not itemize deductions
- Make a gift that is not subject to the deduction limits on charitable gifts
- Further the work and mission of our organization

### Beneficiary Designations

A beneficiary designation gift is a simple and affordable way to make a gift to support DCAC. You can designate us as a beneficiary of a retirement, investment or bank account or your life insurance policy.

#### Benefits of a beneficiary designation gift:

- Support the causes that you care about
- Continue to use your account as long as you need to
- Simplify your planning and avoid expensive legal fees
- Reduce the burden of taxes on your family
- Receive an estate tax charitable deduction
