The mission of Denver Children's Advocacy Center is to prevent abuse, strengthen families, and restore childhood. We respond to reports of child abuse and neglect, provide comprehensive counseling services to child victims and their non-offending family members, and collaborate with our community to deliver prevention-focused initiatives.

Our Programs

Rapid Response

Forensic Interviewers and Family Advocates ensure families receive child-centered care when abuse or neglect is reported.

Treatment

Therapists develop comprehensive treatment plans and provide trauma-focused counseling for child victims.

Community Outreach

Prevention experts engage our community members through educational programming to stop abuse before it starts.




Care Kits and Drives:

Through these flexible volunteer opportunities, your group can provide materials that bring comfort and hope to children and families during their most vulnerable moments. We'll provide a targeted list of needed items, making it easy for your team purchase and assemble items that make an immediate, tangible difference in young lives

Kits:

Hair care kits: Includes products and guides for 25 children with textured hair and 25 children with straight hair to develop a healthy hair care routine.



Birthday party kits: Ten families will receive decorations, place settings, and gift certificates to throw a birthday party for their child and 10 attendees.



Hygiene kits: 25 children and 25 teens with limited access to basic hygiene products will receive essential products for personal maintenance.



Meal kits: Provides ten families with a week of nutritious and balanced meals to reduce stress in times of emotional or financial hardship.



Therapeutic craft kit: Provides 24 clients with a sensory glitter jar and a positive message to assist with regulation and minimize trauma symptoms.



Donation Drive Examples:

Comfort items: Selecting a book, stuffed animal, or blanket after processing trauma provides clients with a comfort item to mark the beginning of their healing journey. Your team will collect new, tag-on therapeutic or sensory items for children to pick out after their forensic interview or first therapy session.

Holiday gifts: Many of the families we serve have limited resources to provide gifts for their children during the holidays. Your team will collect and wrap new, tag-on gifts for DCAC to distribute to families in Denver with the goal that every child can experience the joy of the holiday season.
